You will recall that Mr. Feehely, counsel for the Town of New Tecumseth, indicated at the above-noted hearing that his client's objections to the Permit were based on the existence of the development applications currently before the Town. It is my recollection of the submissions that he candidly indicated that should the applications be withdrawn the Town's objections would be resolved.

You will further recall that, after Mr. Feehely's submissions, a member of County Council asked me if my client was prepared to withdraw the outstanding development applications that were filed with the Town of New Tecumseth in 2003. Unfortunately, I was not able to adequately respond to the question as I did not have my client's instructions.

I am now in a position to respond to the question. Attached is correspondence to the Town of New Tecumseth in which my client withdraws the outstanding development applications and authorizes the Town to close its files.

Since the existence of those development applications was of obvious interest to County Council, and considered relevant to its deliberations, I would ask that you provide to County Council a copy of this correspondence and attachments.

Given the submissions and position taken by Mr. Feehely at the appeal, I would ask that he further confirm that now that the development applications are no longer extant that his clients objections have been resolved.
