1. AWARE Simcoe considers the preservation of farmland, the protection of water resources and natural heritage, and providing transparency and accountability in government decision making to be the primary issues of this election.

Our goal is to elect representatives who support those objectives. Do you agree with this?

Ongoing gravel pit extractions on French's Hill, the water recharge area, now threaten to destroy this precious water. Will you work to protect this important local resource?

ANSWER: YES

Aggregate occurs throughout Ontario and pristine water only occurs here we must continue the path of preserving this forever.

ANSWER: The Official Plan/Zoning by-law review that the new term of council will have in front of them with the public right out of the gate is vital to the protection of our farmlands for present and future generations. We are a rural municipality and the desire by the residents and myself is very strong to maintain that!

7. Simcoe County Council chose a county forest in Springwater Twp – zoned Agricultural, as the site for a (much needed) waste handling facility, the Environmental Resource Recovery Centre (ERRC). Many residents in Simcoe County objected to this location, pointing out that this is an industrial use and there are suitable properties zoned Industrial where the facility should be built. What is your view?

I have never supported this location and still today cannot believe this was allowed to proceed! I stand to lobby that legislation needs to be enhanced to include the protection of our forests, wetlands, waterways, schools from and

all future ERRC facilities in our county. Looking to other countries to create better ways of incinerating waste and reducing our carbon footprint is far more progressive and creates new industries in our county and township moving forward.
